Who is the devil?

Could the devil be a fallen angel? “For God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment” (2 Peter 2:4). It could be that pride was the sin that caused this fall. Listen, “Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil” (1 Timothy 3:6).

Could the devil be the serpent? “Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden” (Genesis 3:1). “And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him” (Revelation 12:9). “But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ” (2 Corinthians 11:3).

Could the devil be a lion? “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour” (1 Peter 5:8).

Is the devil a father? “Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it” (John 8:44)

Could the devil be other people? “But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou are an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men” (Matthew 16:23). “And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Somon’s son, to betray him” (John 13:2). “Let not man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed (James 1:13-14). “For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of

light. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness: whose end shall be according to their works” (2 Corinthians 11:14-15). “Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves” (Matthew 7:15).

What about Christians, could they get easily discouraged because of what the devil is doing in the guise of other people? Notice what Paul says, “Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us” (1 Thessalonians 2:18). How was Paul hindered from coming unto them? Why did the Lord have to appear to Paul at Corinth? “Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city” (Acts 18:9-10). Paul was being attacked by Jews and by erring brethren that demanded that the Gentiles be circumcised. This was discouraging and yet Paul needed the encouragements to help him along his Christian walk. Yes, even seasoned Christians can get discouraged. We cannot let that happen

Now let us consider that the devil can take many forms, animals, people and try to discourage every member here, we cannot let that happen, for if it does he wins and we lose. Who wants to lose heaven, I don’t; therefore remain encouraged! Love, Keith
