PSALMS 139:14 I PRAISE YOU, FOR I AM FEARFULLY AND WONDERFULLY MADE. WONDERFUL ARE YOUR WORKS; MY SOUL KNOWS IT VERY WELL.

Snow!

Wasn't the snow wonderful last week? And there was a lot of it. It was a wonderful scene when it was falling and then seeing a field that had not been disturbed was a wonderful sight. Several of you had fun playing in it and some even built snow men or snow women! How many snowball fights were there? It was wonderful to see and beautiful to behold. Did you thank God for the snow? The Bible speaks of snow twenty four times in the King James Version of the Bible. One of the most interesting is when Job mentions snow. He says of snow, "Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? Or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail" (Job 38:22). There are great agricultural benefits that come from the snow and hail. There are certain chemicals which are in both snow and hail that are needed for crops to grow. So when it snows it helps our farmers.

Proverbs offers many wise saying about snow. One is found in the section about the virtuous woman (Proverbs 31). In verse 21 of that section it says this, "She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household are clothed with scarlet." This woman takes great pleasure in making sure that those of her household had the proper clothes for that time of the year. She knows that if her household goes into the cold wet snow that they will have protection from that kind of weather.

Isaiah has the most famous saying about snow. He states by inspiration, "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool"(Isaiah 1:18). This verse states that we are to reason together. We need to study what God would have us to do to be right with Him. We find later in the book that our sins and iniquities have separated us from God (Isaiah 59:1-2). So we are to be searching how God wants us to be reconciled back to Him. Yes, how we can be reconciled back to Him. Sin is described in Isaiah 1:18 as being scarlet. Yet we can be like the snow or wool; pure and free from sin.

The snow that fell last week was pure white. We can stand before God pure and white as that snow was, if we will do what He says. David, after being told that he had sinned by the prophet Nathan, said, "Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow" (Psalm 51:7). David, himself was a prophet, and

although he is talking of having his sins taken away we must follow this example of submission to God's plan for dealing with our sins.

For us to stand before God who is described by Daniel thusly, "I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sin, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool; his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire" (Daniel 7:9) we must be pure as the snow. Paul states that this must be done, "That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish" (Ephesians 5:26-27). So we too must be washed to be cleansed from sin. We are washed in the blood of the Lamb (Revelation 1:5). We are washed when we are baptized. Saul was told, "And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). We contact the blood of Christ, when we are baptized into His death (Romans 6:1-4). If you are not like the pure and white as the snow before God why not do so before it is too late. Love, Keith
