Blessed Are Those Who Mourn...

As we examine our world today, we realize that Satan has enticed his followers to commit evil. As a result, innocent people are suffering, especially children and the elderly. The second of the beatitudes taught by Christ encourages those who suffer, stating "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted" (Matthew 5:4).
