Blessed Are Those Who Mourn...

As we examine our world today, we realize that Satan has enticed his followers to commit evil. As a result, innocent people are suffering, especially children and the elderly. The second of the beatitudes taught by Christ encourages those who suffer, stating "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted" (Matthew 5:4). Considering that the word "blessed" means "happy" or "fortunate", it's natural to ask, "Why would someone suffering consider themselves happy or fortunate?" The answer lies in the second part of this beatitude, "... for they will be comforted." Jesus is teaching his disciples, meaning learners who are willing to sacrifice everything for him, what it means to be a part of the Kingdom of God. He knew they would suffer and instructed them to, "Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you" (Matthew 5:12). As God's creation mourns today, including millions of innocent women and children, the same holds true for them. They, too, will be comforted, for God's word tells us so.
