Why do We Wrship on the First Day of the Week

I am sometimes asked why we meet on the first day of the week when one of the Ten Commandments says we should remember the Sabbath Day. The Law of Moses, which included the sabbath commandment, was to the nation of Israel only. It lasted as a binding law until Christ died on the cross. The Law of Christ, which began at Pentecost, is God's law for all mankind today. The Law of Christ teaches that we are to meet on Sunday, the first day of the week. This is the day upon which our Lord arose from the dead (Matthew 28:1; Mark 16:2-6; Luke 24:1; John 20:1). The day upon which the church began, Pentecost day, also was on the first day of the week (Leviticus 23:9-16). Therefore, we can see why the Lord chose the first day of the week as the day of worship for Christians.

One of my Favorite preachers of all time is Marshall Keeble. It is estimated that he baptized over 40,000 people in his lifetime including his own mother. He had a way of saying things that was straight to the point and easy to understand. Some of his sayings are almost poetic. I present to you here some of his reasons we attend worship

We go to Church on the first day of the week the same way that a man goes to a spring – he knows that there he will receive refreshment. In one case his thirst is slacked, in the other his soul's desire is satisfied.

We go to Church on the first day of the week because there one drinks at the "Fountain of Grace". It is there depressed souls seeking relief find joy unspeakable, making melody in our hearts to the Lord.

We go to Church on the first day of the week because there we get a foretaste and an anticipation of the joy we will have when we step over into the Father's house of many mansions and join that inner circle that surrounds the throne, singing the praise of him who loved us and washed us from sin in his own blood.

We go to Church on the first day of the week because there we are taught the tragedy of sin and the fact of salvation.

We go to Church on the first day of the week because there we are taught the will of God –His Commandments- His precepts. We are taught how to
